



Items That We Will Clean On Each Domestic Clean

On every domestic, the cleaner will always clean each of the rooms the following:

All rooms /bedrooms

- Remove dust from skirtings, dado rails, window ledges, and top of doors surrounding architraves.
- Remove any finger marks on doors or woodwork.
- All surfaces will be dusted and polished.
- All ornamental items are dust-brushed and polished.
- General tidy-up.
- Vacuuming of lounge suite
- Change of bed sheets
- Vacuuming the floor or micro mop the floor.

Bathroom

- Descale inside the toilet, external and vanity sink
- Shower screen, remove lime scale, polish dry
- Tiles surrounding shower and tub, removing mildew, deep clean bath and wipe dry
- All taps and showerheads, handrails
- All vanity items, toothbrush holders, etc.
- Empty bins, replace a bag
- External mirrors and shelving
- Change of towels
- Vacuum and wash floors

Kitchen

- All external cupboards and kitchen knobs, removing finger marks and grease.
- Surrounding kitchen benches
- Wipe over all items on kitchen benches, toaster, coffee machine, knife holder, etc.
- Dining table and chairs dust and wipe clean.
- Slash back on tiles, kitchen taps and sink limescale and wipe dry sparkle
- Inside Microwave
- Stove and kitchen extractor hood clean and polished

- Empty bins

The following items are classified as **special instructions**, excluded from the weekly, bi-weekly cleaning. **The client can request special instructions** when signing a contract or by email when required.

- Inside cupboards
- Decluttering of cupboards
- Cleaning of chandeliers
- Cleaning inside and outside windows
